

A Timeline for the Foundational Crisis and the Vienna Circle

- 1874: Cantor introduces *Set Theory*
- 1879: Frege publishes *Begriffsschrift*
- 1893: Frege publishes *Grundgesetze der Arithmetik, Vol I*
- 1899: Hilbert states his 22 axioms for Euclidean geometry.
- 1900: Hilbert's famous lecture at the International Congress of Mathematicians in Paris
- 1902: Frege publishes *Grundgesetze der Arithmetik, Vol II*. Russell's paradox.
- 1910-13: Russell and Whitehead publish *Principia Mathematica*
- 1922: Wittgenstein publishes *Tractatus Logico Philosophicus*
- 1922: Schlick organizes the *Vienna Circle* along with Carnap and Hahn
- 1931: Gödel's Theorem
- 1936: Schlick is assassinated. The Vienna Circle ends.
